“Today sees the commemoration of the 261st Anniversary of the Battle of Minden on 1st August 1759. The 25th Regiment of Foot which later became The King’s Own Scottish Borderers was one of the six British Infantry Battalions who fought so gallantly that day to secure a famous victory. May you wear your Minden roses with the same pride as your predecessors.
